Almost **80 percent** of children who died from maltreatment in 2010 were under age 4 and almost half never reached their first birthday.



Quality, voluntary home visiting for at-risk families can cut child abuse and neglect by as much as **50 percent**.



Survivors of abuse or neglect are almost **30 percent** more likely to be arrested for a violent crime.
